WELCOME TO COLTER BAY VILLAGE RV PARK Let us make planning your trip a little easier!

Thank you for choosing Grand Teton Lodge Company for your upcoming visit to Grand Teton National Park. We look forward to hosting you at the Colter Bay Village RV Park, and would like to share some important information about our property to assist in your travel planning.

Colter Bay Village is a full service area complete with restaurants, gift shops, a grocery store, marina, launderette and gas station. It is located on Jackson Lake, just 15 miles from the south entrance of Yellowstone National Park and 42 miles north of the town of Jackson, Wyoming.

The RV Park is located in a wooded area and offers full hookups with the majority of the sites being pull through. Sorry, tents and open fires or fire containers are not permitted in the RV Park. We do, however, encourage use of the National Park Service picnic area located near the lake where fires are permitted in designated grates. Showers are not included in the RV Park space rental, but at are available at the nearby launderette for an additional fee.

Special Requests

Special requests including location, adjacent sites or specific site numbers are not confirmed prior to arrival. Please be assured that we will make the effort to accommodate any special requests we have received. However, we cannot guarantee a location. Final site assignments will be made on your day of arrival, and our check-in time is anytime after 2:00 pm.

Length of Stay

Due to National Park Service regulations, the maximum stay permitted per vehicle each season is 14 days.

Wildlife & Food Storage

One of the main attractions in the Grand Teton National Park is the wildlife. Wildlife encounters may occur at anytime in and around our facilities. Please visit the National Park Service's website (www.nps.gov/grte) for wildlife viewing information and safety precautions to protect both yourself and animals large and small.

All campers are required to follow National Park Service regulations for the storage of food, utensils, and other items that may attract bears. These guidelines will be explained further at check-in. Additional information about Bear Safety can be found at the National Park Service website under "Plan Your Visit."

Activities

Activities offered at our properties include horseback riding, wild & scenic river raft trips on the Snake River, guided fishing, narrated bus tours of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, Elk Island breakfast and dinner cruises and scenic cruises on Jackson Lake. Information is available online at www.gtlc.com/activities. Activities and marina operations are based on weather conditions and water levels. Advance reservations for activities are highly recommended as space is limited and often fills up prior to arrival. To make activity reservations, please call 1-800-628-9988.
