

Fishing Report- 8/11

Snake River flow out of Jackson Lake Dam are approximately 2,000 CFS. The Snake and its tributaries are currently flowing historically low flow. Water temperatures are climbing most days to over 65 degrees in the afternoon. These high temps can be detrimental to catch and release for trout survival. Get an early start and finish early. Great time of year to fish big foam fly patterns. Below Jackson lake dam has been fishing rally well probably due to the colder temperature of the water being released from Jackson Lake Dam.
